FAMILY PLANNING, FERTILITY AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT

An IUSSP Project sponsored by the

WHAT: To produce policy-relevant evidence on family planning and fertility in towns and cities and their links to urban welfare.

WHERE: Sub-Sahara Africa and South Asia.

HOW: Fellowships for skill building of early to mid-career researchers of the region to conduct policy-relevant research.

FEATURING: Intensive mentoring and training as well as policy outreach at local, national and international levels.

WHO: Citizens of countries in sub-Saharan Africa or South Asia, who have received a Ph.D. within the past ten years and who are currently affiliated with established institutions in these two regions are eligible. **Applications to study settings with high fertility, high unmet need for FP and high rates of urbanization are particularly encouraged.**

WHEN: The first set of fellows will be selected by 5 January 2019 to conduct research in 2019–2020. **Applications for a second round of fellowships** to be active in 2020–2021 will be **due on 1 July 2019.**
