



## Report of the IUSSP Election Committee

The 2013 IUSSP Council Election was conducted via the Internet and all votes cast were automatically tabulated by Votenet Solutions, a third party internet company which provides online voting services to associations, governing boards, unions, and schools. IUSSP first used their services for the 2009 Election. The possibility was also made for members to vote by a paper ballot. Members had to request paper ballots by 5 August to ensure enough time for paper ballots to reach the voter and be returned to the Secretariat by 1 October. We received only one request for a paper ballot, and given that vote would not be anonymous, the member was requested to vote online. That member did subsequently vote online. Given there were no paper ballots to count, the Election Committee's primary role was observing the elections process by which the Ballot was set up and making decisions on matters concerning the elections. The Election Committee met at the IUSSP Secretariat in September and it was decided that one of the members would view the election results on 2 October once the final vote was tabulated at midnight on 1 October and the results became accessible.

The results of the online ballot and the procedures carried out for the 2013 IUSSP Election have been reviewed and approved by all members of the Election Committee.

Please find attached the election results. A total of 2,184 members were eligible to vote of which 1,237 cast their vote-- 56.6% of eligible voters, the largest participation rate for any recent IUSSP election surpassing the number of voters in 2009. Voter participation was important for all regions, and especially high for Latin America and the Caribbean and Europe.

We, the undersigned, Véronique Hertrich, Catherine Rollet, and Laurent Toulemon, have been fully informed about the whole electoral procedure and we approve the procedure, having examined the counts of votes we declare the following results:
