IUSSP in a nutshell: 2018-2021

Looking Good 😊

- Some 2000 members, including about 700 student members
- 19 Scientific Panels and an Early Career Taskforce
- Flexibly navigating a global pandemic and pivoting to virtual
- More events and more participants than ever before

Looking Not So Good 😞 to think - and act - about

- Membership levels (and fees income) declined but now levelling off
- Core funding for operational costs declining
- Income from special projects and from conference fees needed
- Financial reserves necessary to “make ends meet”

From Cape Town to “Hyderabad”: the Pivot to Virtual

- More events, involving more participants
- A total of 84 activities, including 5 cyber seminars, 8 seminars, 5 conferences, 1 expert meeting, 13 workshops, 16 training workshops, 24 side meetings or special sessions at conferences, 12 public webinars
- A large number of smaller (business) meetings now virtual: “the new normal”?
- Connecting some 6600 participants, about half of them from Low- and Middle Income Countries

IUSSP Anti-Harassment Policy and Code of Conduct

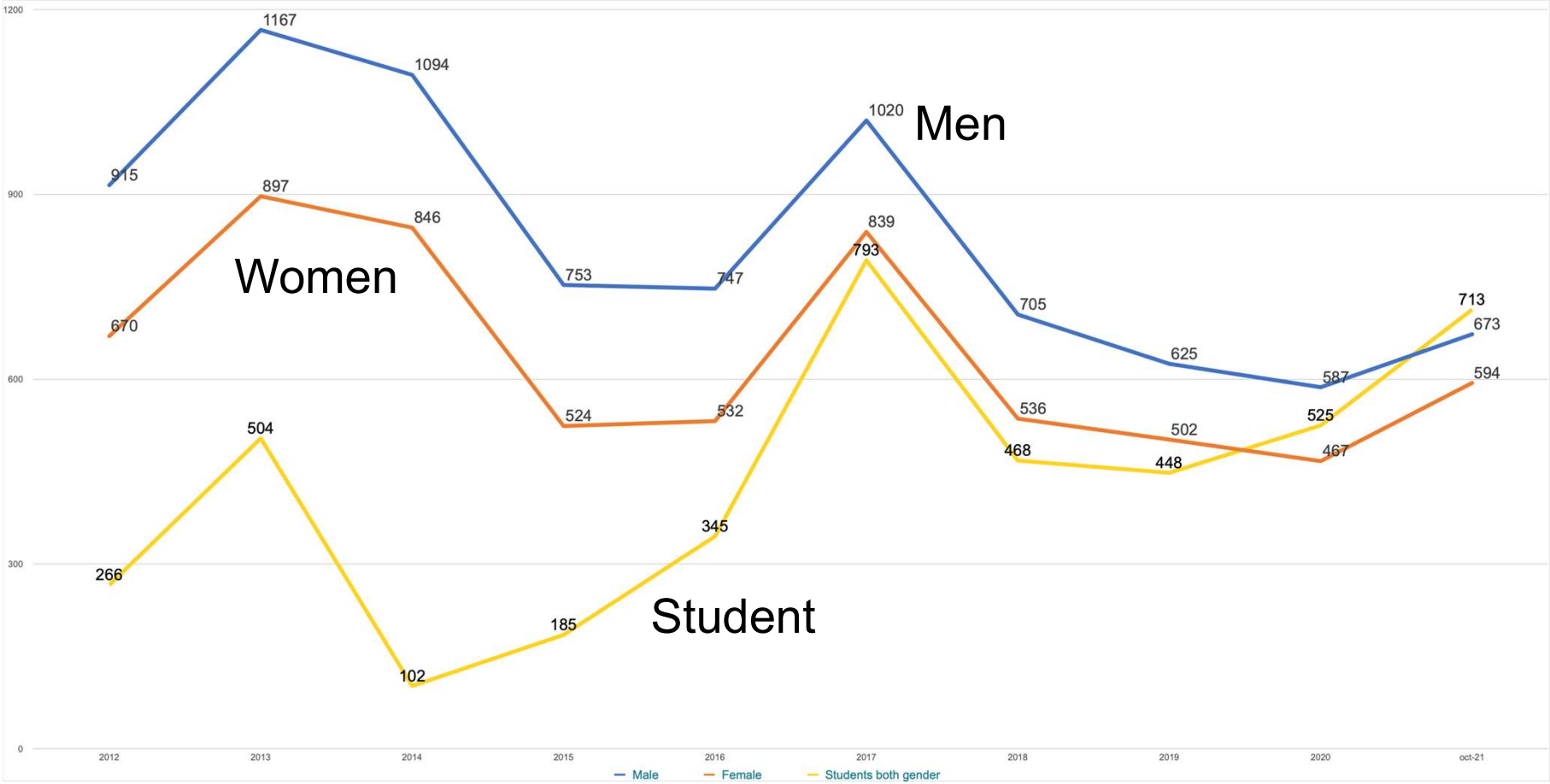

Environment Policy

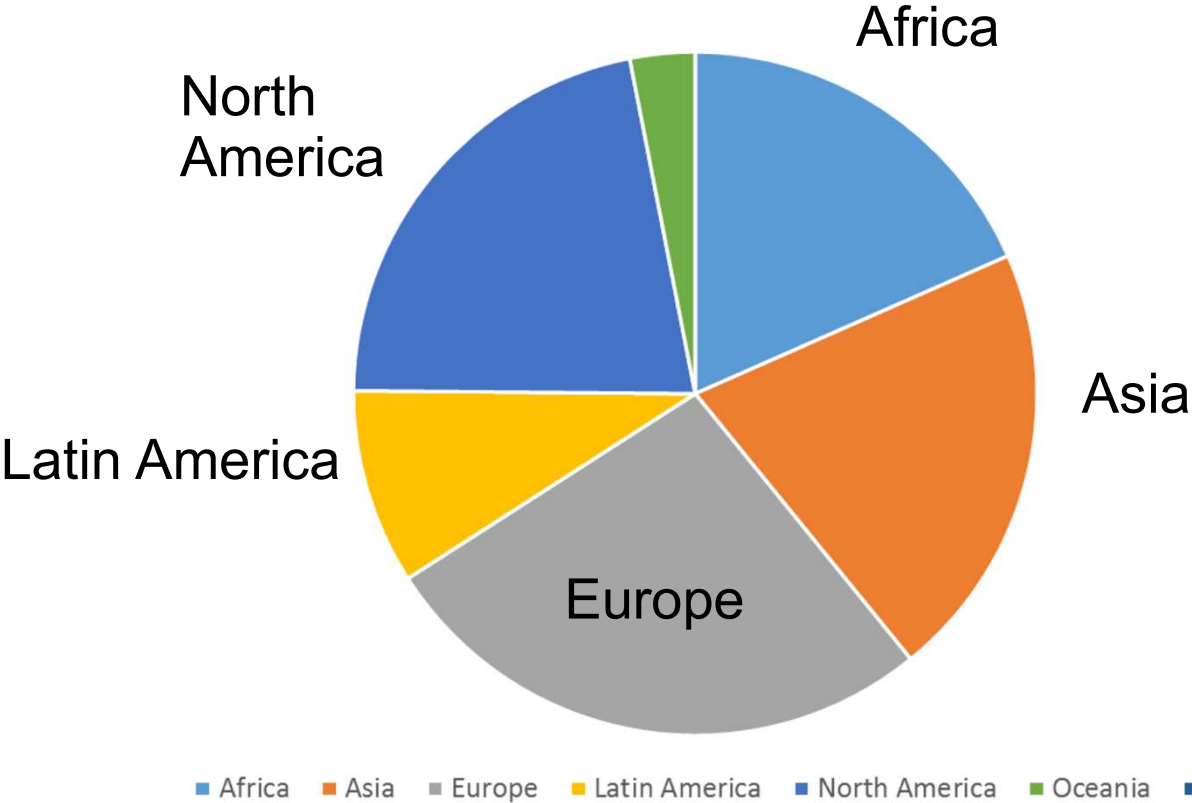
“to decrease the human footprint on the environment”.

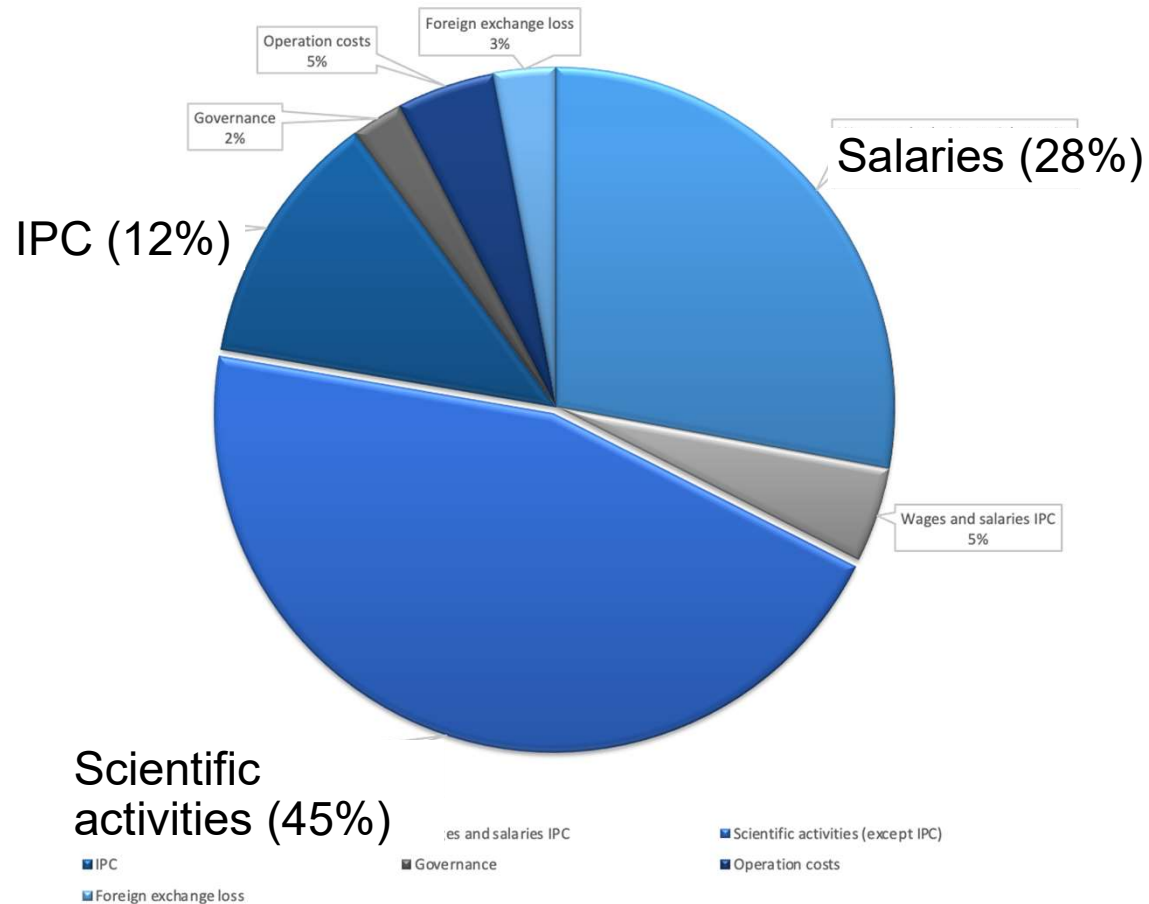
Membership 2012 - (October) 2021



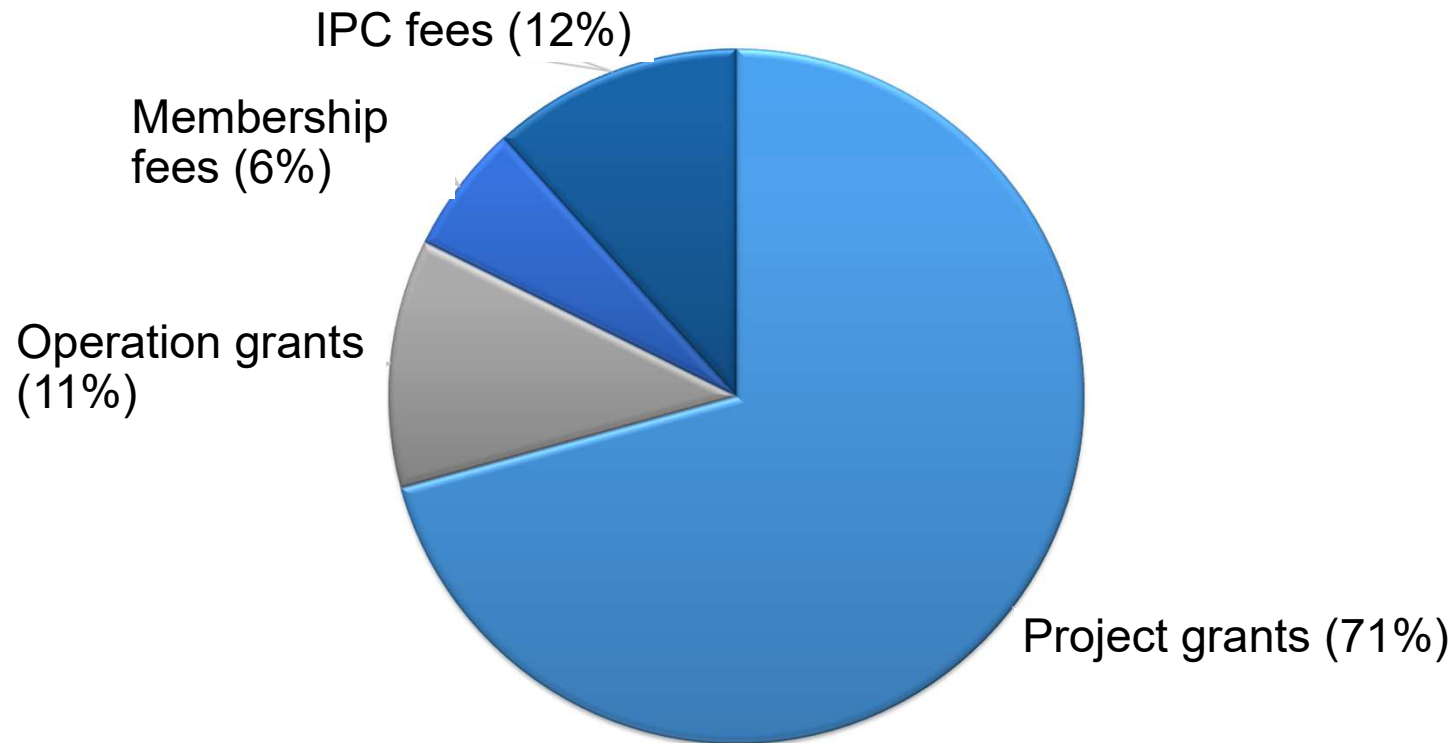
Full members by Region, 2021



IUSSP Expenses 2017 - 2020



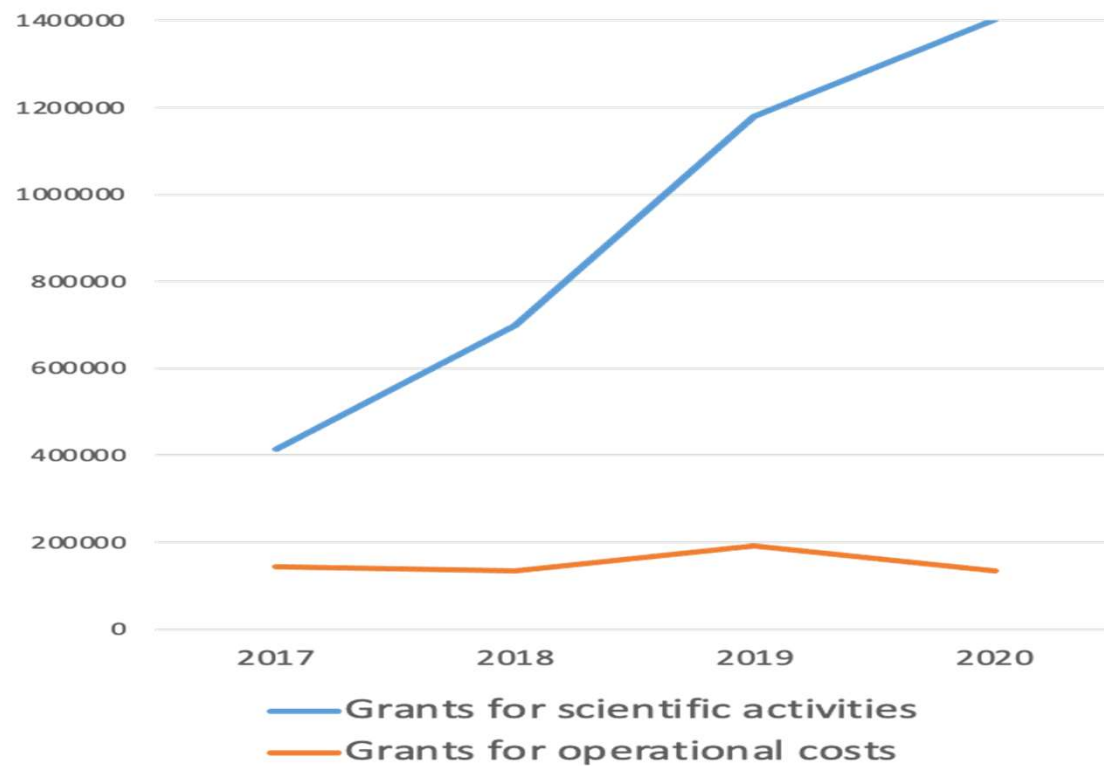
IUSSP Income 2017 - 2020
