BUILD is a five-year project made possible by the generous support of the American people through the U.S. Agency for International Development which seeks to address interlinked Population, Environment and Development (PED) challenges for sustainable development in low- and middle-income countries. It seeks to promote integration of family planning/reproductive health and PED action using a systems' thinking approach.

The BUILD project is led by the African Institute for Development Policy (AFIDEP) and is implementing the project in partnership with Leadership for Environment and Development Southern and Eastern Africa (LEAD SEA); PATH Foundation Philippines Inc. (PFPI); FHI 360; and Pan-African Climate Justice Alliance (PACJA).

Qualifications and experience

- PhD degree in demography, development economics, population studies with PED emphasis or PhD in an environmental sciences subject with research experience in human geography or population studies.
- At least two (2) years conducting PED or related research after PhD qualification
- Experience of conducting research in Low-Middle-Income countries
- Strong analytical skills, including the ability to analyse and manage large data sets.
- Strong scientific writing skills with record of publications in international peerreviewed scientific publications
- Experience of policy engagement at global and national level; delivering training to a diverse group will be added advantages.

• Languages: Excellent command of written and oral English. Knowledge of French is an added advantage.

• **Interpersonal skills**: Team work, managing people, effective communication with people from different cultures
