Report IUSSP Scientific Panel on Lifetime Migration (April 2025)

The <u>IUSSP Standing Committee on Demographic Terminology</u> was created to continue IUSSP's longstanding commitment to a Multilingual Dictionary of Demography. The Committee is also tasked with creating a FAIR version of the Dictionary that will be both human and machine-readable, as described in <u>FAIR Vocabularies in Population Research</u>. In March 2024, IUSSP published a request for technical assistance with our work, and we are very pleased that we have found strong support from partners in several countries. The Committee is currently developing a machine-actionable ontology for the Dictionary that will become part of the "Semantic Web." We also carried out an online survey of IUSSP members to gauge usage of Demopaedia, the current online version of the Dictionary, and interest in a future machine-actionable version.
