2.2 Extend ProFamy into probabilistic model/software

- **○** I will continue working hard and collaborate with our colleagues in China and abroad to innovatively extend our ProFamy model/software into probabilistic household and living arrangement projections model and user-friendly software.
- Our ProFamy extended cohort-component method uses conventional data of demographic rates and summary parameters to project households and living arrangement.
- Thus, ProFamy method provides a highly feasible modelling framework to develop innovative methods/software of probabilistic household and living arrangement projections (PHP) with statistical confidences intervals.







2.2 Extend ProFamy into probabilistic model/software (continued)

Thanks very much for technical supports from UNPD, we will work hard to innovatively develop ProFamy probabilistic households and living arrangement projections methods & user-friendly software.

We also discussed and reached consensus with outstanding researchers from various countries, and we plan to do probabilistic households and living arrangements projections for informed decision-making first in several countries including China, and then

extend to other countries globally.
