Who we are

The French Institute for Demographic Studies (INED) is a public research institute. It conducts research on various demographic issues (fertility and family, health and mortality, migration, etc.) and inform the public about current developments.

What you will do here

You will be working as a post-doctoral member of the ANR Worklife Project which examines the impact of non-standard working hours on fertility, partnership and gender inequalities. You will belong to an interdisciplinary team of sociology, economics, demography and management researchers from various institutions. The team has an international scientific committee (University of Oxford, UQAM, University of Lausanne, University of Turin, EHESS) that meets during regular workshops.

Your main mission will be to pursue panel analysis of the relationship between non-standard working hours, work-life balance and fertility, mainly using the 2019 wave of the French working conditions survey <u>https://dares.travail-emploi.gouv.fr/enquete/conditions-de-travail-edition-2019</u>

Under the supervision of the research project leader, Anne Lambert, you will help produce research articles and reports, and present intermediate findings at project meetings. You will present the project findings at national and international conferences. The project involves opportunities for international travel to project team working meetings and presentation of papers.

Requirements

- Doctorate in economics, sociology or demography.
- Advanced skills in the statistical and econometric methods required for panel data analysis, such as fixed-effect models, first-difference estimators, etc. Use of Stata and/or R software is essential.
- Proven interest in the project's themes.
- Ability to read, communicate and draft scientific documents in English.
- Communication skills in French.
- Self-motivation and good organisational skills.

This is a full-time position starting in November 2021 (flexible starting date) on a 12-month contract.
