

IUSSP Population, Inequality, and Climate Change (PICC) Scientific Panel 2021-2025

Report for the IUSSP General Assembly

The IUSSP Scientific Panel on Population, Inequality, and Climate Change (PICC) oversees an IUSSP project to produce policy-relevant evidence on the interaction of population dynamics with inequality and climate change. With funding provided by the Agence Française de Développement (AFD) and Population Reference Bureau (PRB), the panel in collaboration with AFD hosted a policy forum/side event with a climate change and inequality lens; supported panel members to present academic papers in conferences; and provided travel and mentorship to early career researchers working on climate and inequality.

The panel organized a hybrid panel/side event at the ARUA Climate Change and Inequalities Symposium - Transforming Social Inequalities Through Inclusive Climate Action (TSITICA) in March 2023, Cape Town, South Africa.

The panel provided support to five members to present academic papers that address the central theme of the panel at the Inequality, Work, and Nature conference in November 2023 in Cape Town, South Africa.

Finally, through an agreement with ACEIR and PRB, the panel provided travel and mentorship to 5 early career researchers to participate in the ARUA Climate Change and Inequalities Symposium, March 2023, in South Africa.
