**SUMMARY BIOGRAPHY**

Dr. Mohammad Mainul Islam is a professor and former Chairman of the Department of Population Sciences at the University of Dhaka, Bangladesh, with over 24 years of experience in Population and Development, Demography, Sociology, Global Health, Public Health, and China Studies. He received his Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Sociology from the University of Dhaka, Bangladesh. He received his PhD in Demography, specializing in Population Health, from Peking University, China. Later, he completed a Global Health Research Capacity Strengthening Program Postdoctoral Fellowship at McGill University, Canada. Dr. Islam also received training at the Johns Hopkins Fall Institute in Barcelona (Universitat Pompeu Fabra), Stanford University, Brown University, the University of Quebec at Montreal (UQAM), the University of Laval, the University of Bergen, and Beijing Language and Culture University (BLCU).

Professor M. M. Islam was recognized as one of the top 2% scientists on Elsevier and Stanford University's list in 2025. In recognition of his academic achievements, he received the 'First Prize of Academic Excellence Award' from Peking University. In 2010, he was named the Nick Simons Scholar of the New Investigator in Global Health program of the Global Health Council (GHC) in the United States. He is a two-time winner of the New Voices in Global Health (NVGH) program, receiving the accolade in 2014 and 2016 at the World Health Summit (WHS) in Berlin, Germany. He contributed to over 92 scientific publications, including research findings as the first author in *The Asia Pacific Journal of Sustainable Development*, *The Lancet*, *Lancet Global Health*, *PLOS ONE*, *Journal of Population and Social Research*, and *China Population and Development Studies*. He is currently working with Springer Nature on the upcoming book, *Bangladesh's Social Transformations as a New Nation*. He attended over 300 international and national conferences worldwide. He regularly contributes to both the print and electronic media. The Government of Bangladesh appointed him to the Executive Committee of the National Population Council (NPC) in March 2025. He is currently a member of the Syndicate of Comilla University (nominated by the

Government of Bangladesh for 2025-2026). He was also a member of the 'Task Force' to formulate and implement recommendations on the Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS), SID, and the Ministry of Planning, through discussions on the quality, transparency, and availability of produced statistics. He is also a member of the Population Expert Committee (PEC) for Integrating Population Dynamics and Development Issues into National Plans and Policies (PD4Development) Project, General Economic Division (GED), Planning Commission.

Professor Islam served as the Project Director for the Strengthening the Capacity of Teaching and Research Facilities at the Department of Population Sciences, University of Dhaka (Second Phase), a project funded by the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) and the Ministry of Education, Government of Bangladesh, from 2018 to 2021. Dr. Islam was elected to the Syndicate— the highest decision-making body of the University of Dhaka — for two consecutive terms between 2010 and 2014. Professor Islam is involved with various associations, including the International Union for the Scientific Study of Population (IUSSP), the Asian Population Association (APA), and the International Sociological Association (ISA). Prof. Islam was a Member of the Scientific Group of the Asian Population Association (APA): Changing Household Structure, Aging, and Well-being in Western and Southern Asia, 2022-2024, and currently a Member of the Scientific Group on Climate Mobilities, Migrants and Health, Asian Population Association (APA), 2025-2027. He serves as a consultant to the Government and various United Nations agencies, including the UNFPA, the General Economic Division (GED) of the Planning Commission, the Director General of Family Planning (DGFP) of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, and UNFPA Bangladesh. As a national consultant of UNFPA Bangladesh, Dr. Islam played the key role in developing the first *Bangladesh National Planning Strategy, 2025-2030*. He is also a key member of the technical committee of the National Guideline for the *Prevention of Son Preference and the Risk of Gender-Biased Sex Selection, 2022*. He is the Vice-President of the Association of Bangladesh-China Alumni (ABCA). He is a regularly invited speaker in various government training programs for higher-level government officials at the Planning Commission, National Defence College (NDC), BBS, DGFP, PATC, NADA, NAPD, and the Parliament Secretariat, among others. His work broadly focuses on population and development, Demography, Sociology, Global Health, reproductive health, child and youth populations, population aging, population and health policies and programs, urban health, population dynamics, climate change, displaced and ethnic populations, and Sinology/China studies.
